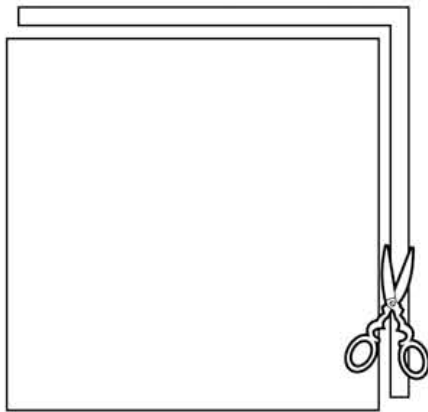


How To Make A Paper Butterfly

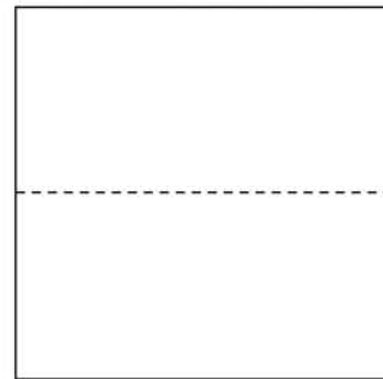

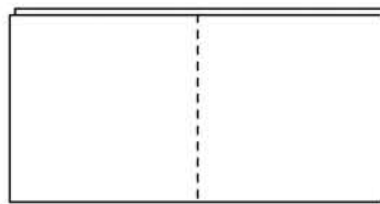
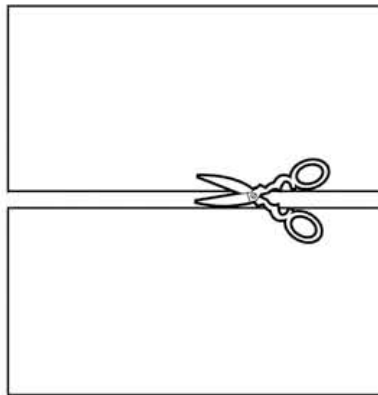
Origami paper works quite nicely for this toy.



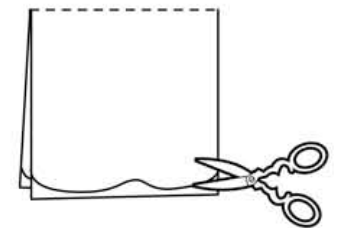
1. Cut the edge off of a square of paper.
This is the butterfly's antenna.



2. Fold the square in half to find the middle point.

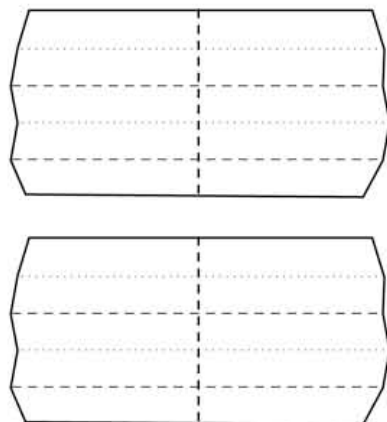


4. Place the two rectangles on top of each other and fold in half.



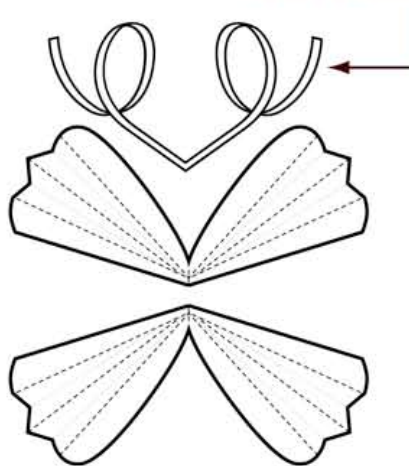
6. Round off the edges of the rectangles to make the wings.

8. Cut along the fold to make two rectangles.



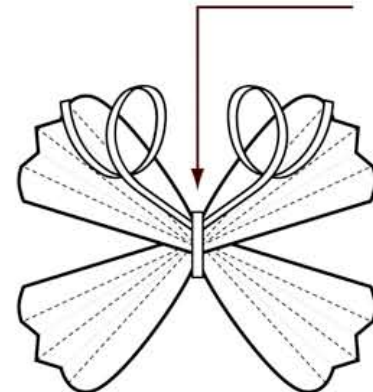
5. Pleat each rectangle to make little fans and then refold in middle.

CURL ANTENNA BY RUNNING THE PAPER STRIP AGAINST THE EDGE OF THE SCISSORS



7. Curl the L shaped piece to make the antennas. Arrange the two rectangle pieces as shown. Cut a two and a half piece of tape in half longways.

THIN PIECE OF SCOTCH TAPE



8. Wrap the piece of tape around the middle of the butterfly. Gently open the wings and hang your butterfly from a thread.
