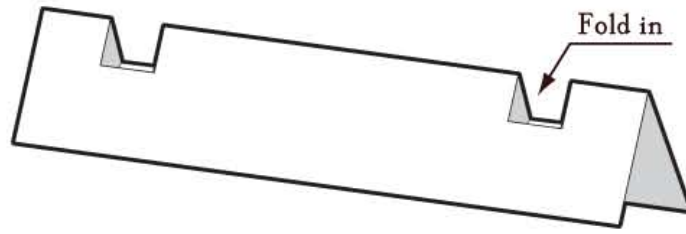


Thinkin' Logs
